
1. 練習正確發音 先學習每個字母(alphabets)的聲音, 再學者二合字母(digraphs)及 三合字母(trigraphs)





#### Tips for reading the stories together

Children enjoy re-reading stories and this helps to build their confidence and their vocabulary.


#### Tips for reading Floppy Did This!

- Talk about the title and look through the pictures so that your child can see what the story is about.
- Read the story to your child, placing your finger under each word as you read.
- Read the story again and encourage your child to join in.
- Give lots of praise as your child reads with you.
- Talk about the story.
- Do the fun activity on page 60.
